EAGLES ADVENTURE CAMP 2023 INFORMATION

<u>CAMP DATES</u> - Camp begins *Monday*, *June* 12th and ends on *Friday*, *August* 4th.

<u>CAMP HOURS</u> – Camp will begin at 8:00 am and will dismiss at 4:00 pm. Students can be checked in at 7:45 am through the elementary school office without being charged for extended care.

<u>EXTENDED CARE</u> – Extended care opens at 6:30 am and closes at 6:00 pm. Students must be signed in for beforeschool care and signed out of after-school care by a parent or other authorized person (must present identification at check-out area in the afternoon), helping us maintain a high level of security. (Payments are to be made as often as necessary to keep account current. A late fee of \$20 will be charged to any account which is 10 days past due)

<u>STUDENT DROP-OFF</u> – Students should be walked in by a parent or other authorized person and signed in through the Elementary School Office. Parents or authorized persons dropping off students are encouraged to park in the North parking lot near the Elementary School Office. Parents dropping students off and picking students up will enter and exit the campus from the west end of the campus through the ALFC Administration Building driveway off of Red Oak or the northeast gate near the hospital. <u>Parents are not permitted to park in front of the ALFC Administration Building.</u>

<u>STUDENT PICK-UP</u> –Students will remain in their classroom until 4:15 pm (15 minutes after dismissal time). Students not picked up by 4:15 pm, will be automatically checked into extended care. Parents or authorized persons picking up students will check out students through the Elementary School Office. Parents picking up students will enter and exit the campus from the west end of the campus through the ALFC Administration Building driveway off of Red Oak or the northeast gate near the hospital. <u>Parents are not permitted to park in front of the ALFC Administration Building.</u>

<u>EMERGENCY / PICK-UP / EMAIL INFORMATION</u> – Each family should go into FACTS and double check your home/mailing address, email address for both parents (both parents <u>cannot</u> have the same email address), home and cell phone numbers for parents, as well as all the emergency contact information in case of an emergency. Please be sure all updates are completed by **June 2**nd.

PARENTSQUARE - UCA will be using **ParentSquare** to communicate with you this school year.

<u>DAILY CAMP ATTIRE</u> – Please take time to carefully review the required camp attire document, as it will be strictly enforced beginning the first day of camp. Parents are expected to make sure that their children are dressed in accordance with the camp dress code and not deviate from it. Students who are not properly dressed will not be admitted to class and must be brought camp-approved attire from home or picked up by a parent. Subsequent dress code violations will result in further consequences.

BREAKFAST & HOT LUNCH—Progressive Catering for Schools is our campus food provider. Breakfast and lunch will be available to be PRE-ORDERED online through FACTS. An outline of how you may purchase breakfast and or lunches is enclosed. The price for breakfast per day is \$5.50 and for lunch it is \$6.00 per day. If your child needs an emergency lunch it will be \$8.00 and be billed to your child's account

HOT LUNCH – Progressive Catering for Schools is our campus food provider. All lunches must be PRE-ORDERED online through FACTS. An outline of how you may purchase lunches and snack cards is enclosed. The price for lunch per day is \$6.00. If your child needs an emergency lunch it will be \$8.00 and be billed to your child's account.

<u>WATER DAYS-</u> Girls are only allowed to wear one piece bathing suits, no two-piece suits and no tankini suites. All 3rd-6th grade girls are required to wear shorts over their bathing suites. Incoming 5th & 6th grade boys are required to wear a t-shirt/rash guard with their trunks. We highly encourage water shoes for all campers. Students will need to bring sunscreen and towels on these days.

<u>CAMP SUPPLIES</u> – Please make sure your child comes prepared each day of camp with a hydro flask filled with water, and a beach towel with their name on it. Additional supplies will be required based on camp activities; parents will be notified in advance.

NO ELCTRONIC DEVICES- Students are not allowed to bring iPad, iPod, iPhone watches, cellphones, tablets, laptops or gaming devices to camp.

<u>MEDICATION</u> – Please pay close attention to the UC Academy policy on administering medication to students. Forms are included in this packet for your child's physician to authorize UC Academy to assist in administering medication (yellow form) and/or to allow your child to carry an inhaler on his/her person rather than leave it in the school office (pink form).
