Elementary Dress Code

At UC Eagles Adventure Camp, we agree that our appearance, inside and out, is a reflection of God in our lives to those we encounter. Dress and grooming at United Christian Academy should be characterized by neatness, modesty, and moderation. The purpose of appropriate dress is to show honor to others, focus on the heart, and not regard dress as simply a matter of individual expression. As such, we require students to follow these policies, and for families to support them.

In all issues of school dress, UC Eagles Adventure Camp reserves the right to determine what is immodest, immoderate, extreme, or otherwise unacceptable in clothing and hairstyle. Students who are not properly dressed will not be admitted to class and must be brought a change of clothing from home or picked up by a parent.

Tops

The top styles are allowed:

T – Shirt (Boys & Girls)

Tank Tops with 1" shoulder strap or thicker (Boys & Girls)
(no spaghetti straps allowed)

Bottoms

The bottom styles allowed are:

Jumper, romper, skort, shorts, pants (Girls)

Shorts or pants (Boy)

Shoes

All shoes are encouraged to be comfortable and must have a flat heel and closed heel and toe. Students may wear water shoes only on assigned water days. No sandals or flip flops are permitted.

Water Days

Girls: Should wear ONE piece swimsuits only with swim shorts over. Tankinis & Bikinis are NOT allowed. Students will not be allowed to participate if they do not have the proper attire.

Boys: Should wear swimshorts and a rashguard. Students will not be allowed to participate if they do not have the proper attire.

All personal items should be labeled with their first and last name including: personal bags, towels, under clothes, socks waterguns etc;

Field Trip Attire

Unless the director specifies a different dress for that day, the students must wear their camp shirt on field trips. Field trip attire will be at the director's discretion, depending on the type of trip. ParentSquare communications will be issued regarding this information.

Theme Dress Up Days

There will be opportunities for students to have "theme dress up days". These days will be communicated in advance. These are encouraged days, not mandatory.

Hair

Girls – Hair must be neat and not draw undue attention to the individual; the hair must be kept out of the eyes (may not fall below eyebrows). Unnatural hair color or hairstyles will not be allowed.

Boys – Hair must be neat and well-groomed and should not impair vision. The length of the hair may not be longer than the top of the collar (use regular collared shirt as guideline), cover more than half of the ear, or fall below the eyebrows. The hairstyle must not draw undue attention to the individual (e.g., mohawks, faux-hawks, tails, spikes, etc.).

Certain exceptions may be made for cultural and religious considerations. All such exceptions must be requested in writing to school Administration and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Dress Code Violation will be imposed if dress code is not followed. Parent / Guardian will be responsible for any adjustments needed before student is checked-in to summer camp for the day.
